



Online Shopping Risks and Security Tips

Online shopping offers convenience but comes with inherent risks. Remaining vigilant is essential to mitigate potential losses.



Choose reputable online shopping platforms

- Shop through official websites or well-established platforms to avoid uncertain or unregulated platforms.



Ensure website and connection security

- Verify website SSL certificate (https://) and avoid public Wi-Fi for secure transactions.



Do not disclose passwords to anyone

- Safely manage login credentials and never share account, banking details, or one-time verification codes with anyone.



Provide only necessary personal information

- Provide minimum information for transactions to reduce the risk of personal data leakage. Consider guest transactions if registration is not required.



Double-check transaction information

- Review transaction information provided by bank and verify amounts and currencies involved. Contact your bank immediately if you notice any abnormalities.



Beware of counterfeit promotions

- Be cautious of unknown sources' promotion emails or SMS. Please exercise caution before clicking to prevent malicious software attacks and personal data leaks.
